Sidelights may be a combination light, instead of two separate lights as shown in figures 2 and 5.

## **Anchored Vessels**

**AT NIGHT:** All vessels at anchor must display anchor lights. If your vessel is less than 164 feet in length, then its anchor light is an all-round white light visible where it can best be seen from all directions. (Figure 8)

**DURING THE DAY:** All vessels at anchor must display, forward where it can be best seen, a black ball shape. (See Figure 9)



**EXCEPTIONS:** If your vessel is less than 23 feet in length, then it is not required to display an anchor light or shape unless it is anchored in or near a narrow channel, fairway or anchorage, or where other vessels normally navigate.

If your vessel is less than 65.6 feet, then it is not required to display an anchor light if it is anchored in Inland Waters in a special anchorage designated by the Secretary of Transportation.
